

MND Prerequisite Course Review Flowchart

Admissions Requirement

At least 72% (B) final mark in all prerequisite courses:

- Two-terms/ full-year (6 credits or equivalent) Human Physiology (e.g. BIOL 155, BIOL 153, CAPS 301)
- One-term/ half year (3 credits or equivalent) Introductory Biochemistry (e.g. BIOL 201, BIOC 202)
- One-term/ half-year (3 credits or equivalent) Statistics (e.g. STAT 200, LFS 252, BIOL 300, EPSE 482, FRST 231)
- One-term/ half year (3 credits or equivalent) Introductory Nutrition (e.g. FNH 250)
- One-term/ half-year (3 credits or equivalent) Introductory Food Science (e.g. FNH 200)

Instructions for Applicants: Use the flowchart to determine what steps you must take to show that your relevant courses meet <u>each</u> of the five UBC MND admissions pre-requisite requirements

If you answer **No** to Q3, complete the manual course review.

- 1. Download the <u>Prerequisite Checklist</u> and conduct a self-review for any pre-requisites that are not listed.
- 2. Attach the related course syllabi **in English**; they must include:
 - Schedule of the topics taught each week
 - Outline of the course objectives and/or content
 - Format of the course (i.e., Lecture)
 - Grade distribution (i.e., 30% midterm, 60% final exam, 10% participation)
- 3. Declare the course(s) in your Self-Report Form and submit the checklist and relevant syllabi as one PDF document
